

FAST TRACK TRANSFORMATION POLICY

COMPILED January 2017

All member provinces and divisions will need to take the following into account from the start of 2017 season.

Each Division will field their standard allotted quantity of anglers plus one POC angler, this naturally excludes any POC anglers that have qualified on Merit to the allotted number of anglers to attend National Trials.

Should a particular Division not have any POC anglers participating at this stage in their events, then a Division may loan/borrow an additional POC angler from another Division to fill the POC slot. National Trials should therefore incorporate 5 POC Anglers, approximately 10% of the National Trials entrants.

The proposal for the upcoming National Trials 2017, is that the Starting sequence will remain the same and the additional POC anglers will depart boats 51-55 each day.

At the National Trials, the POC angler that finishes highest will automatically be incorporated into the Region 5 Protea Team Reserve position.

The second highest POC angler will be selected for the Association Team and will fill the Reserve position.

SABAA Mancom and the respective executives will endeavour to instil the knowledge and training to ensure that the said anglers grow in confidence and ability for the next season.
